Preventive medications to help keep you healthy

Bright Health Plan, in compliance with the Affordable Care Act (ACA), offers certain preventive medications for a \$0 copay.

To receive these medications, you need to:

- Have a prescription from a licensed health provider, including for over the counter (OTC) medications
- Fill your prescription at an in-network pharmacy
- Qualify for the appropriate age, disease state

Note: This list may change based on ACA guidelines.

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Aspirin

These products help prevent cardiovascular disease and colorectal cancer for high-risk adults.

Bowel preparation

Medications for cleaning out bowel before colonoscopy. Colonoscopies are used to screen for colorectal cancer in adults age 50-74.

Statin-prevention

Medications to reduce the risk of heart attack and stroke by helping lower cholesterol levels in the blood for at-risk adults age 40-75.

<i>Lovastatin oral tablet 10 mg, 20 mg, 40 mg</i>	\$0 copay for members age 40 through 75
<i>Pravastatin sodium oral tablet 10 mg, 20 mg, 40 mg, 80 mg</i>	\$0 copay for members age 40 through 75
<i>Rosuvastatin calcium oral tablet 5 mg, 10 mg</i>	\$0 copay for members age 40 through 75
<i>Simvastatin oral tablet 5 mg, 10 mg, 20 mg, 40 mg</i>	\$0 copay for members age 40 through 75

Folic acid

Supplements to prevent birth defects in women who are pregnant/may become pregnant.

<i>Folic acid oral tablet 1 mg</i>	QL (30 EA per 30 days)
<i>Folic acid oral tablet 400 mcg, 800 mcg</i>	OTC QL (30 EA per 30 days)

Fluoride

Supplements for children age five years and younger, whose water supply is fluoride deficient, to prevent tooth decay/cavities.

<i>Sodium fluoride oral tablet chewable 0.55 mg (0.25 ppm F) mg, 1.1 mg (0.5 ppm F) mg, 2.2 mg (1ppm F)</i>	\$0 copay for 5 yrs of age and younger
<i>Fluoritab oral tablet chewable 1.1 mg (0.5 ppm F)</i>	\$0 copay for 5 yrs of age and younger
<i>Sodium fluoride oral solution 1.1 m/mL (0.5 ppm F)</i>	\$0 copay for 5 yrs of age and younger

Low blood sugar

Medications used to treat severe low blood sugar in members with diabetes who use insulin.

<i>Glucagon emergency injection kit 1 mg</i>
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Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) prevention

Medication for preexposure prevention of HIV in those at an increased risk.

<i>Truvada 200 mg/300 mg tablet</i>	\$0 copay if utilizing for HIV prevention
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Medication-assisted treatment for substance use disorder

Medication to help those who are dependent on opioid medication.

<i>Buprenorphine Hcl/naloxone Hcl sublingual tablet sublingual 2 mg/0.5 mg, 8 mg/2 mg</i>	QL (90 EA per 30 days)
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Smoking cessation

Treatments to help adults quit tobacco to prevent health problems associated with tobacco use.

Breast cancer prevention

Treatments to help prevent breast cancer for those 35 years of age or older who are at increased risk.

<i>Tamoxifen citrate oral tablet 10 mg, 20 mg</i>	\$0 copay for those 35 years of age or older for the primary prevention of breast cancer
<i>Raloxifene Hcl oral tablet 60 mg</i>	PA \$0 copay for those 35 years of age or older for the primary prevention of breast cancer
